

Out of Province Inspections

Most vehicles needing registration that are coming from outside of Alberta must have an out of province inspection completed prior to registering.

These inspections first require an inspection request form that can be purchased at the Registry and then taken to one of the [Approved Inspection Locations in Alberta](#). To purchase this form you would need your photo ID and your proof of ownership documents (current out of province registration, bill of sale, lease agreement, etc.).

There are some vehicles that may be exempt from this inspection as long as one of the following conditions are met:

1) If a vehicle is coming to Alberta from either British Columbia, Saskatchewan or Manitoba and is less than 4 years old:

- Proof of SK/BC/MB registration in the name of the person requesting the exemption is provided
- Vehicle must be present at the Registry for VIN verification

2) If the vehicle has been inspected within the last 90 days in either British Columbia, Saskatchewan or Manitoba and:

- Proof of SK/BC/MB registration in the name of the person requesting the exemption is provided
- Original Government issued inspection certificate issued in the last 90 days is presented
- Vehicle must be present at the Registry for VIN verification

3) The vehicle is brand new and purchased or leased within the last 90 days in a Canadian jurisdiction and previously registered to the same individual in another Canadian jurisdiction:

- Bill of sale or lease agreement must be in the name of the person requesting the exemption
- Vehicle must be present at the Registry for VIN verification

4) The vehicle is brand new and purchased in the United States:

- The bill of sale or lease agreement is no more than 90 days old and in the name of the person requesting the exemption
- Stamped vehicle import form and original Certificate of Origin must be provided
- Vehicle must be present at the Registry for VIN verification

5) If the vehicle has a GVW over 11,794 kg the Out Of Province Vehicle Inspection is NOT required. However a Commercial Vehicle Inspection will be required in its place.

- The Commercial inspection can be no more than 14 days old
- The vehicle must be registered commercially
