## Canmore Registry & License Relocating to Alberta from Another Province/Territory

Within 90 days of becoming an Alberta resident, you are required to change your driver's license, vehicle registration & insurance over from your home province. To begin this process you will be required to produce **Canadian Drivers License, Proof of Legal Presence & 1 piece proving residency.** 

**Examples** of acceptable identification/legal presence documents & proof of residency are as follows:

## **IDENTIFICATION\***

Drivers license with photo <a href="PLUS">PLUS</a> one of the following

Valid Canadian Passport
Canadian Indian Status Card
Permanent Resident Card
Nexus Card

Original Birth Certificate
Record of Landing
Canadian Citizenship Card
Work Permit (must have at least 3mths remaining)

If you have *lost* your drivers license you will need to produce a confirmation letter or a driver's abstract from the province/territory in which you have relocated from, plus two pieces of Identification (1 With Photo).

\*Neither temporary documents nor photocopies of documents will be accepted, all documents must be originals.

## PROOF OF RESIDENCE\* One of the Following:

Town of Canmore Tax or Water Bill Residential lease or mortgage documents Letter from employer on company letterhead Utility, telephone, gas or cable bill Current bank &/or credit card statement Income tax return Pay Stub

\*All proof of residency must be dated within the preceding 3 months.

You will be required to surrender your out of province driver's licence to Alberta Registries. The cost for an Alberta Drivers License is **\$100.00**, and it is valid for 5 years. If you are obtaining a class 1, 2 or 4 you will also need to bring in a **Current Medical** done by an Alberta doctor.

## **Registration**

- 1) Bring proof of ownership (including VIN) for the vehicle to get a **Request for Vehicle Inspection.** Cost for this form is **\$9.00.**
- 2) Bring your vehicle to an Alberta Transportation Certified Mechanic for an **Out of Province Safety Inspection.**
- 3) Obtain Alberta Insurance.
- 4) Bring your drivers license, proof of ownership for the vehicle, proof of current Alberta insurance & the original certificate from the mechanic (this certificate is only valid for **14 days from date of inspection**). Registration costs will vary based on your expiry month, cost is **\$93.00** for 1 year.
